Truth isn't truth: Research integrity for a responsible Science

Abstract

In front of the grand challenges facing our societies at the era of the millennium, Science has a word to say. Yet, is the scientific method really appropriated by our fellow citizens and their political representatives? To which point do they trust it? Has this thrust not been marred by high-profile cases of fraud? Having recently become conscious of the “elephant in the room”, French research is setting up a mechanism for consolidating research integrity”

Olivier Le Gall is an agronomical engineer and doctor in biology. He has managed a research team in plant virology at INRAE Bordeaux for several years, before he directed the division “plant health and the environment” of the institute, then the entire portfolio of scientific affairs. Since 2017 he has been chairing the new French advisory board for research integrity (Conseil français de l'intégrité scientifique, CoFIS).
